Subject: Fall, 2017 Preliminary Enrollment Report

Enclosed is the Preliminary Enrollment Report for Fall 2017. These data reflect projected university enrollments as of September 1, 2017. This year, total university enrollment is expected to be 50,000. This is consistent with longer term enrollment planning.

Enrollment highlight graphics are attached along with the Preliminary Enrollment Report. The official enrollment count will occur the evening of September 25, 2017.

Fall 2017 enrollment figures are preliminary at this time. The official count will occur at quarter of semester on the evening of September 25, 2017. The following represent our best current estimates. This year's enrollment is expected to approximate 50,000 students, consistent with longer term enrollment planning. A final report will be circulated after the quarter of semester statistics are known.

Entering Class

- Approximately 36,150 applications were received this year (well within the five year range of 30,340 to 37,480). Our first time undergraduate enrollments are expected to approximate 8,000 students (again, well within the five year range of 7,842 to 8,154).
- Average grade point is expected to approximate 3.7 and average ACT scores approximate 26.2. The average grade point continues a steady increase over recent years. Both grade point and average ACT score reflect a 3 to 4 percent increase over the past ten years.
- First time Honors College enrollment is estimated at 640 students comprising approximately 7.9 percent of the entering class.
- This year's undergraduate entering class is estimated to include 1,745 students of color, or 24.5 percent of the domestic total (slightly above the five year range of 1,355 to 1,705).
- New transfer enrollment is approximately 1,670 students (within the five year range of 1,449 to 1,670).
- The combined entering class and transfer enrollment total, inclusive of summer admits, is estimated to be 9,770 students, approximately 75.4 percent of which are Michigan residents.

Undergraduate and Graduate Students

- Total undergraduate enrollment is estimated at 38,950 students, down 140 from the previous year reflecting slightly larger first time enrollments offset by a diminished return rate due to increased graduations in the previous year and improvement in the economy. Total undergraduate enrollment reflects 75.9 percent Michigan residents.
- The proportion of female students to total undergraduate enrollment is approximately 50.6 percent (the same as last year).

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- There are approximately 1,835 new graduate students at the master's and doctoral levels, an increase of 100 over the previous year.
- New graduate professional enrollment totals approximately 585 students, down 24 medical students from the previous year.
- Total graduate enrollment, including graduate professional students, is expected to approximate 11,050 students, down about 200 from last year. This change is attributable to fewer returning graduate students and largely reflects improvement in the economy.

University

- Total university enrollment for students of color is estimated at 9,760 students, an increase of 321 or 22.6 percent of the domestic student body total.
- The enrollment mix between undergraduate, graduate and graduate professional students is expected to be 77.9 percent, 17.2 percent, and 4.9 percent, respectively.
- It is anticipated that the Broad College of Business and the colleges of Social Science, Natural Science and Engineering will have the largest enrollments as of the official enrollment count date.
- The MSU College of Law total enrollment is currently 853 students of which 265 students are new.

The attachment provides the detailed preliminary enrollment statistics. Final enrollment data will be provided following the official count at the end of September.

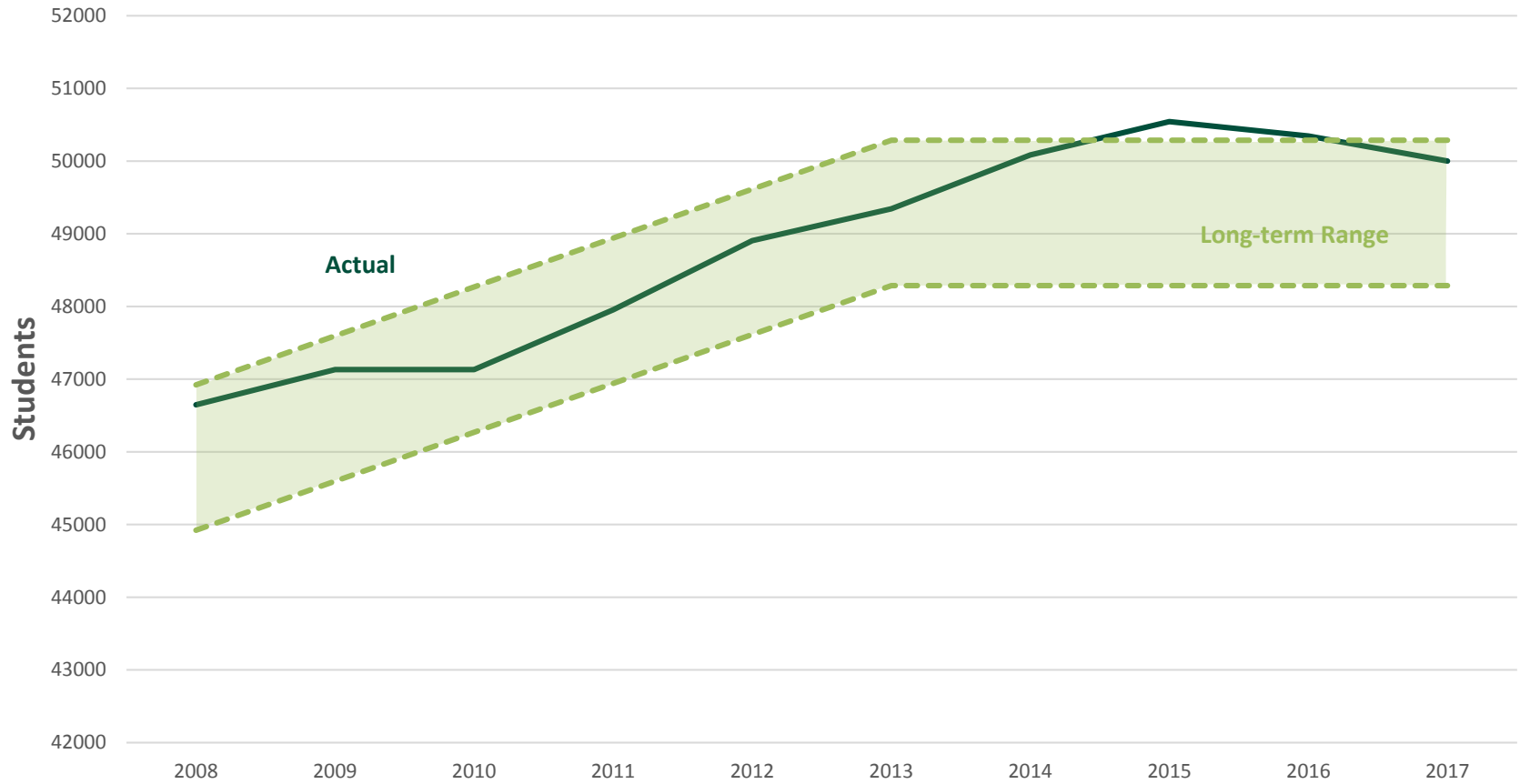

Fall Enrollments

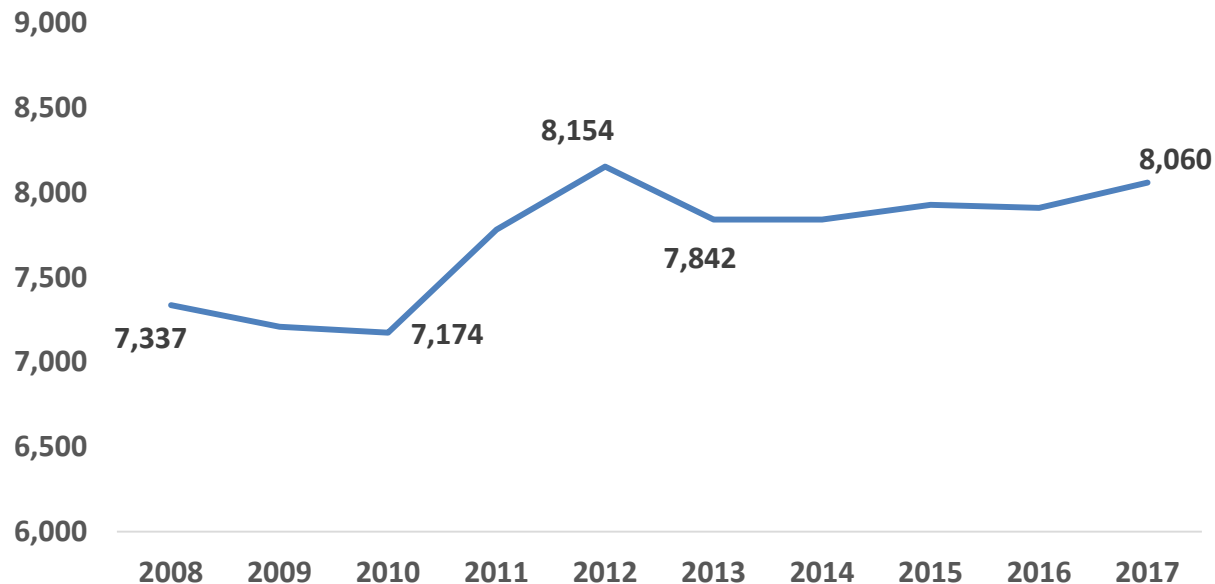

- First time undergraduate enrollment** of 8,060 reflects a 1.9% increase from last year's total of 7,911

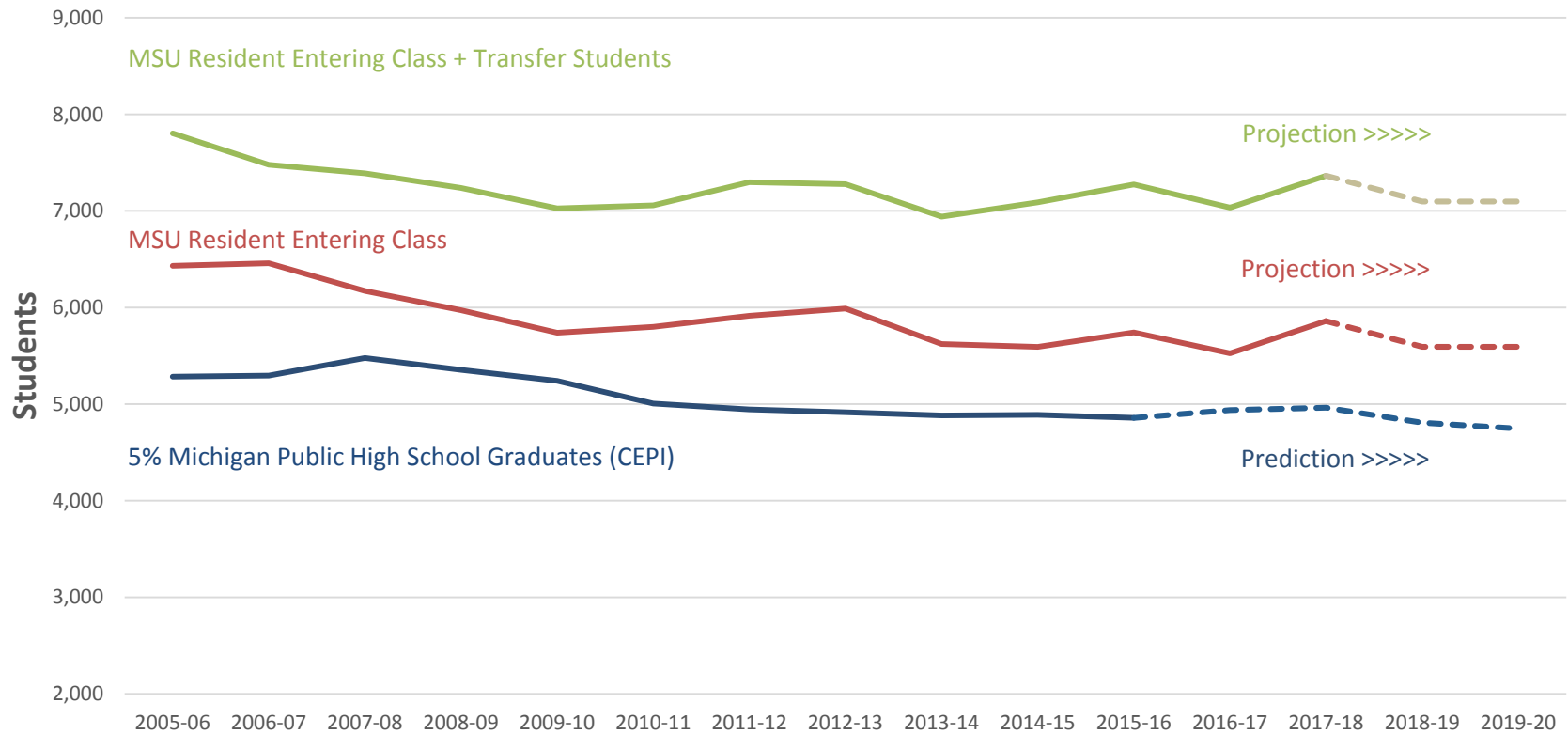
MSU First Time Undergraduate Class

Michigan High School Graduates



MSU benchmarks resident enrollment at 5% of the Michigan high school graduating class. In 2015-16 there were 97,146 public high school graduates and in 2016-17 MSU enrolled 5,526 from Michigan in the entering class, or 5.7% of the total.

The above reflects the estimated distribution of Michigan high school graduates by ACT performance level. The highest performance level is positioned at the base of the graph and progressively diminishes moving to the top.

Undergraduate Residency

- For total undergraduates 76 percent are Michigan residents
- The entering class plus new transfer students is comprised of 75 percent Michigan residents
- The entering class is comprised of 72 percent Michigan residents

Undergraduate Entering Class Statistics

- High School grades defined by first 25th and 75th percentile range between 3.52 and 3.95 up slightly over previous years, with a median of 3.74
- ACT scores defined by the 25th and 75th percentile range between 23 and 28 similar to previous years, with a median of 26
- Total students of color in the class approximated at 24 percent of the domestic total
