Subject: Fall, 2016 Enrollment Report

Enclosed is the Fall, 2016 Enrollment Report. These data reflect university enrollments as of September 26, 2016. This year, total university enrollment is 50,344. There are no material changes from the Preliminary Enrollment Report which was prepared last month.

Enrollment highlight graphics are attached along with the Enrollment Report.

This year's Fall semester total university enrollment is 50,344, a decrease of 199 students, or 0.4 percent under last year's enrollment total of 50,543, consistent with planning targets.

Entering Class

- Demand for admission to MSU remains strong as 37,480 applications were received this year. The entering class for Fall 2016 (comprised of first time Summer and Fall enrollees) is 7,950 students, down marginally (17) from the previous fall and consistent with planning targets.
- Average grade point average is 3.7 and average ACT is 26.1, greater than or consistent with prior years.
- First time Honors College enrollment is 667 students, or 8.4 percent of the entering class.
- This year's undergraduate entering class includes 1,700 students of color, or 24.7 percent of the domestic total.
- New transfer enrollment is 1,640 students. Beginning Fall, 2014, the methodology for counting transfer students changed to better align with IPEDS federal reporting. New transfer student headcount data includes Fall semester plus the preceding Summer session.
- The MSU entering class and transfer enrollment total is 9,590 students, down from 9,637 in the previous year and consistent with planning targets. Of those students, 73.4 percent are Michigan residents.

Undergraduate and Graduate Students

- Total undergraduate enrollment is 39,090, compared with 39,143 in Fall, 2015.
- Of total undergraduate enrollment, 75.5 percent are Michigan residents. The proportion of female students to total undergraduate enrollment is 50.6 percent (up from 50.4 percent).
- Total graduate enrollment, including graduate professional students, is 11,254 students (down 146 students from last year).
- There are 1,739 new students at the master's and doctoral levels (down slightly from 1,748).

Enrollment Report Page 2.

- New graduate-professional enrollment totals 609 students, which is consistent with the enrollment plan for the medical schools.

University

- Total university enrollment for students of color is 9,439 students (up from 9,147) or 21.9 percent of the domestic student body total.
- The enrollment mix between undergraduate, graduate and graduate professional students is 77.6 percent, 17.3 percent, and 5.1 percent, respectively.
- The Broad College of Business, the College of Social Science, the College of Natural Science, and the College of Engineering have the largest enrollments as of the official enrollment count date.
- The MSU College of Law total enrollment is 845 students, 259 of which are new.

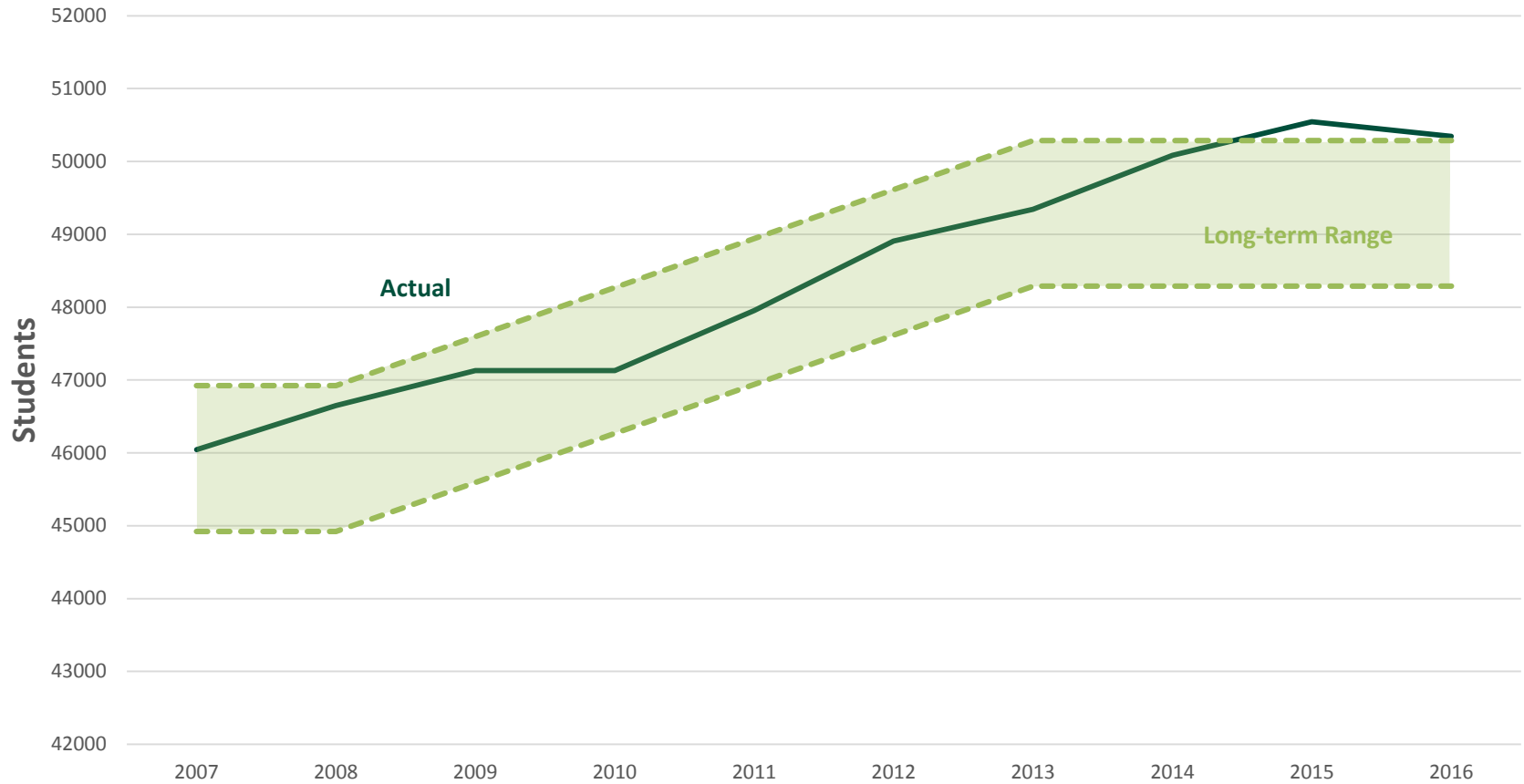

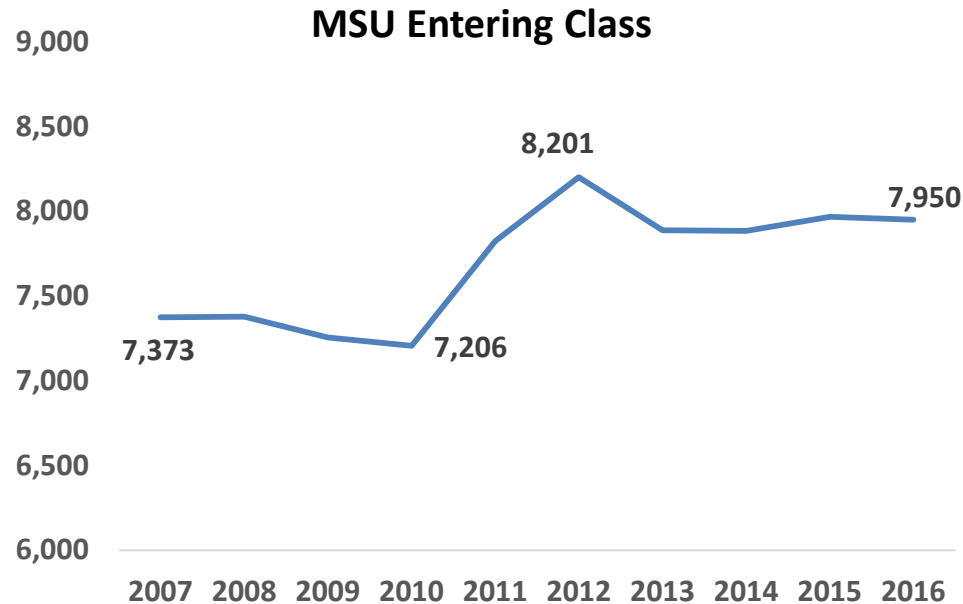

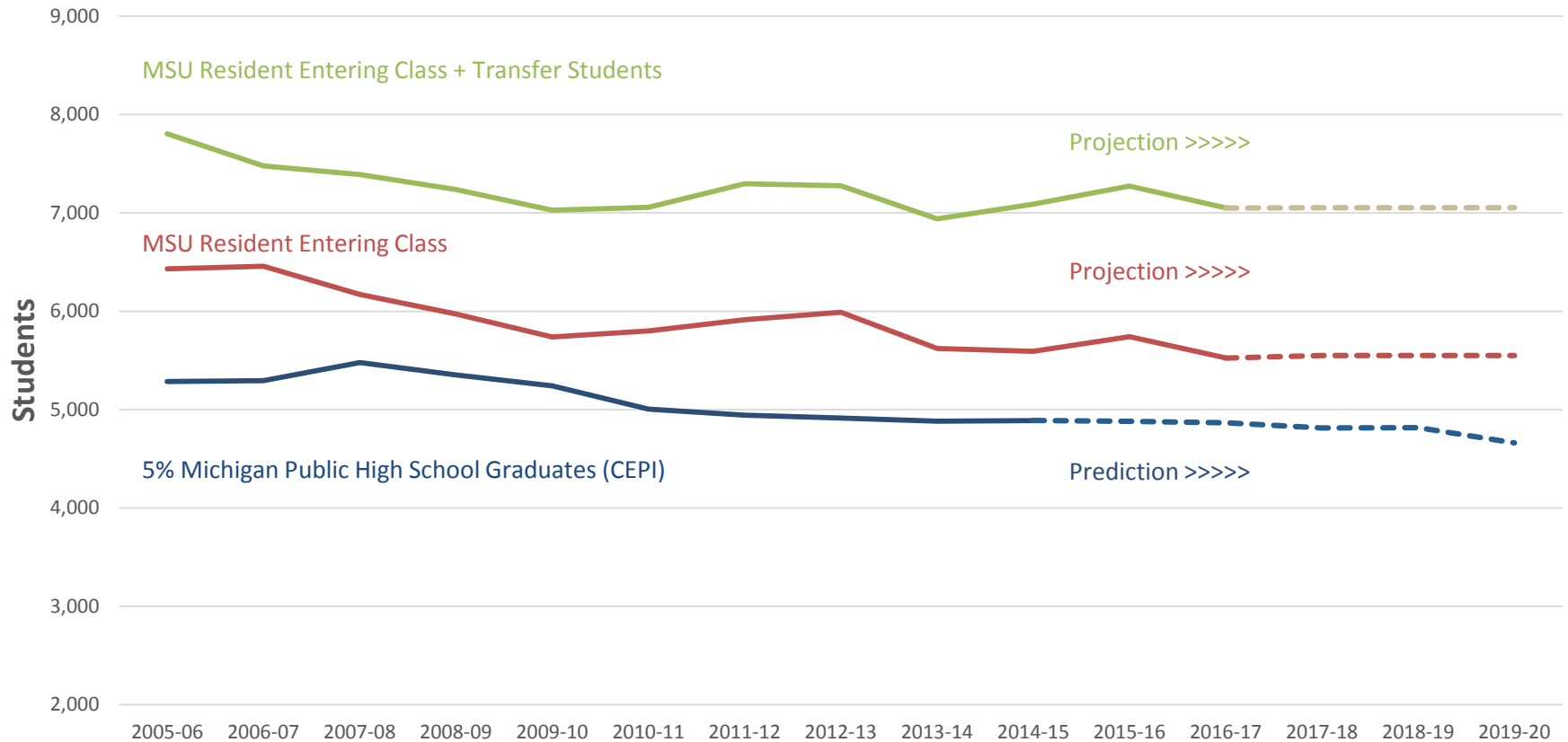


Undergraduate Entering Class Enrollment

- Entering class enrollment of 7,950 reflects a 0.2% decrease from last year's total of 7,967



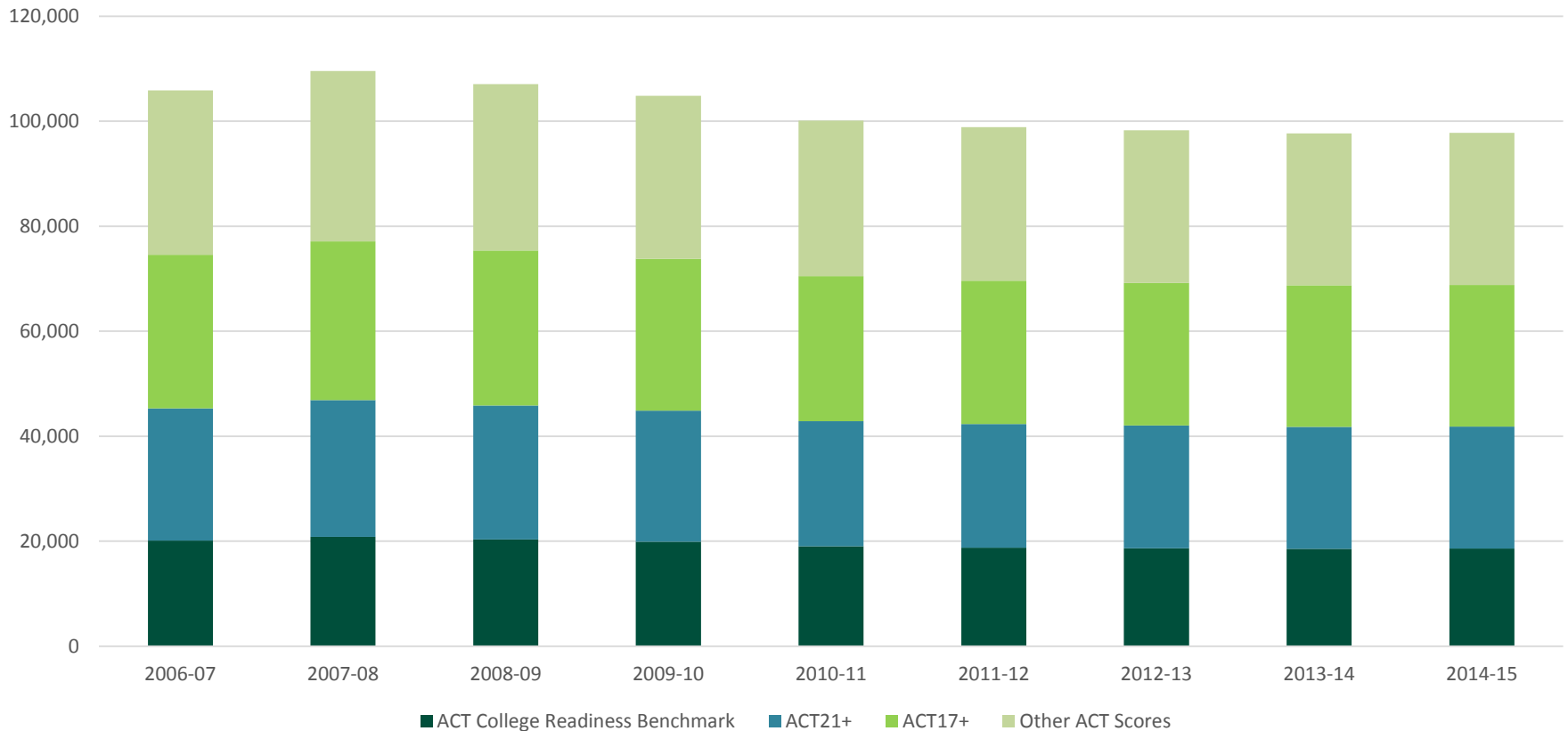
Michigan High School Graduates



MSU benchmarks resident enrollment at 5% of the Michigan high school graduating class. In 2014-15 there were 97,773 public high school graduates and in 2015-16 MSU enrolled 5,742 from Michigan in the entering class, or 5.9% of the total.

The above reflects the estimated distribution of Michigan high school graduates by ACT performance level. The highest performance level is positioned at the base of the graph and progressively diminishes moving to the top.

Undergraduate Residency

- For total undergraduates 75 percent are Michigan residents
- The entering class plus new transfer students is comprised of 73 percent Michigan residents
- The entering class is comprised of 70 percent Michigan residents
- Across the Big Ten institutions, 65 percent of first time undergraduates are estimated to be state residents

Undergraduate Entering Class Statistics

- High School grades defined by first 25th and 75th percentile range between 3.50 and 3.94 up slightly over previous years, with a median of 3.74
- ACT scores defined by the 25th and 75th percentile range between 24 and 29 up slightly over previous years, with a median of 26
- Total students of color in the class approximated at 25 percent of the domestic total
