Subject: Fall, 2018 Enrollment Report

Enclosed is the Fall 2018 Enrollment Report. These data reflect university enrollments as of September 24, 2018. This year, total university enrollment is 50,351. There are no material changes from the Preliminary Enrollment Report which was prepared last month.

This fall we welcome our largest entering class ever, 8,442 new undergraduates, including a record 4,415 women. They come having achieved an average high school GPA of 3.73, continuing the steady upward trajectory seen in recent years, and include 2,032 students of color, a record high 26.3% of the domestic total. In addition, this entering class includes 724 new honors students, amounting to the largest percentage of an entering class to date.

Michigan State University recruitment occurs across local, national and even international dimensions. Students this year come from 142 countries, every state in the United States and every county in Michigan.

In the Fall of 2018, MSU registered its largest first time undergraduate class to date for an entering class of 8,442 students, including a record 4,415 women. This year's total enrollment is 50,351 students, the second largest on record.

Undergraduate Entering Class

- MSU received 33,129 applications, consistent with the range over the last five years.
- The average high school GPA was 3.73, continuing a steady increase over recent years.
- First time Honors College enrollment is 724 students, comprising 8.6 percent of the entering class.
- This year's entering class includes 2,032 students of color, a record high 26.3 percent of the domestic total.
- New transfers total 1,590 students.
- The combined entering class and new transfer total, inclusive of summer admits, is 10,032 students, 79.6 percent of which are from Michigan.

Undergraduate and Graduate Students

- Total undergraduate enrollment is 39,423 students, up 427 from the previous year, and is MSU's highest total undergraduate enrollment.
- Women make up 50.7% of the total undergraduate enrollment, consistent with prior years.
- There are 1,680 new graduate students at the master's and doctoral levels, down 158 from the prior fall.
- New graduate professional enrollment totals 605 students, up 20 medical students from the previous year.

- Total graduate enrollment, including graduate professional students, is 10,928 students, down 95 from last year.

### University

- Total university enrollment for students of color is 10,359 students, an increase of 605 over last year, and accounts for 23.5 percent of the domestic student total. This is MSU's most diverse student body to date.
- The enrollment mix between undergraduate, graduate and graduate professional students is 78.3 percent, 16.7 percent, and 5.0 percent, respectively.
- The Broad College of Business and the colleges of Engineering, Natural Science and Social Science have the largest enrollments among MSU colleges.
- The MSU College of Law total enrollment is projected\* at 764 students of which 210 students are new.
